 Minutes were reviewed from the April meeting. A motion was made by Carol to approve the minutes seconded by Jeff. Motion passed.

Pastoral Report/Notes: Pastor Moyer

- Reviewed the parochial reports. Laurie commented it would be great to have the reports in our office mailbox the Sunday before the Board meeting.
- Church Extension Fund is providing a \$2,000 grant for aesthetic upgrades to the church and grounds that we will partially use for liturgical banners to be placed by the baptismal font for the different seasons.
- Caution on the use of photos and images. Some district churches have received cease & desist orders and fines up to \$10,000 for not getting prior approval to use the images. There are guidelines available in the office.
- Always be addressing the unbelievers/pre-believers in your midst. Always be catechizing.
- There's a severe shortage of pastoral candidates in the Synod. Fifty-six just came out of St. Louis and approximately fifty out of Ft. Wayne while there are 422 calling congregations.

President's Report: Phil Whitmer

- Update on the 500th Anniversary Reformation Worship Service. They continue to take ticket orders (sign-up available in the office). Two buses have been filled and they're considering reserving a third.
- Recognition is overdue for Darlene Baker so she will be featured as the Volunteer of the Month at all worship services one week soon.

V.P. Property & Maintenance: Sam Siegel

- Big coffee pots are all working properly.
- American Heritage Girls' Memory Lane showing confirmands, Pastors and Faith's history. They did a great job of clean-up.
- New copiers in the office.
- New energy saving light bulbs in Heins Hall are now instant on. They're more expensive but are
 partially paid by a Consumers Energy rebate and use substantially less electricity.
- Cameras are working well and are very helpful. Sam can check them from home.

V. P. Salary & Personnel: Jeff Moellering

V. P. Finance & Stewardship: John Crawford

- We continue to run with just over three months' expenses covered in cash on hand.
- March's giving year to date was \$54,000 behind 2016 but April has closed that deficit to \$27,000.
- A stair lift for the steps leading to Heins Hall will cost \$5,000 \$6,000 per Access Co. Still getting other quotes and exploring how to fund.
- Faith is approved to continue a line of credit with Church Extension Fund. Need to provide them with copy of updated By-Laws and Constitution.

- Update on the David Gelatly Trust. The disbursement will be \$10,277, not the full value of the house as David had made changes to the trust. Funds are to be used for charitable purposes as congregation decides – no restrictions.
- Elections were held and 260 ballots were cast with all positions being elected..
