# Scholarship Application Instructions

*Higher Education*

**APPLICATION IS DUE APRIL 1**

The members of Faith Lutheran Church wish to encourage Christian education of our youth in primary, secondary, and higher education. We believe that this enhances faith formation and leads young people toward lives of Christian service and ministry. To this end, the Congregation has allocated resources to provide scholarships to attend an LCMS affiliated school which offers K-8 primary education, to any LCMS affiliated high school, and to pursue degree programs at colleges within the Concordia University System and our two Synodical seminaries.

## **Part 1: What institution will you attend?**

Faith Lutheran Church provides scholarships to attend Concordia University System member universities and seminaries of the Lutheran Church – Missouri Synod.

## **Part 2: Student's Name and Home Address**

Enter your name and your home address.

## **Part 3: Degree Program(s)**

Enter your major on the first line. The major you enter must be as shown in the university's catalog. If you are undecided, then enter "undecided." Also, enter the names of any second major you are pursuing and minor(s). These must likewise match the college catalog. Then indicate your class level on the appropriate line along with your intended graduation year. If your program has continued beyond the standard 4 years, then check "Senior" as your class level.

## **Part 4: Member Parent**

The student or at least one parent must be a member in good standing of Faith Lutheran Church in Grand Blanc, Michigan, as stated in Section III of the Faith Lutheran Church of Grand Blanc Constitution. Priority will be given to students with a parent(s) who is(are) a member(s) of Faith and in good standing. Enter member parent(s) names in the spaces provided. A step-parent is acceptable for this application.

## **Part 5: Signature**

**The student applying for the scholarship must sign the application form. The completed form must be submitted to the Church Office no later than 3:00 pm on the date of the application deadline. If the deadline falls on a day when the office is closed, then applications will be accepted until 3:00 pm on the next business day.**

## **Part 6: Statement**

Please tell us what you plan as your future career path. Why did you choose your major and minors? How do they relate to that career path? The maximum length of the statement is 1 single-sided page using at least a 12 pt font. If you are "undecided," then what career path(s) and major(s) are you considering?

## **Part 7 (Office Only): Approvals**

There are 2 approvals necessary in order to be awarded a scholarship:

- The Board of Elders verifies the student or Faith member is in good standing.
- The Board of Congregational Ministry reviews the application and decides on the scholarship award.

**Scholarship funds are paid directly to the university on the student's behalf.  
All decisions by the Board of Elders and Board of Congregational Ministry are final.**
