Secretary's Report

Leslie made a motion with support from Gil to approve the minutes. Motion was approved.

Pastor Report

August worship attendance was up 4% from the month of August in 2024.

Pastor spoke on the Spiritual First Aid workshop being offered in November.

Pastor spoke on his abilities to serve at FLC through the end of the year. At the end of the year, he will step away from serving as in the Intentional Interim Pastor program. Bob Kasper is aware of this decision and will be prepared to work on a replacement if needed.
