Board of Directors Minutes
May 17, 2021

Meeting was called to order at 7:04pm with devotion and prayer led by Pastor Biermann. Shared with the Board the proposed theme for the Fall, based upon Hebrews 12, vs 1 & 2. Verses were read - Theme for the Fall is to keep our focus on Jesus as our direction, our compass, our true north. He is our bearing point – our true north. Proposed logo was shown. In Christ, there is hope and there is joy in Him.

Secretary's Report: Phillip Whitmer

Minutes from the April 19, 2021 were presented. Motion was made by Marcy to accept the minutes as presented. Motion was supported by Sam. Corrections needed, add Sarah Slangor as a visitor and under Outreach and Evangelism, Christie brought a palm frond. All voted in favor of approving the minutes with the corrections noted.

Pre-School Update: Cindy LaFontaine

One week left to end of season. Haven't any Covid related issues since last October. Holding a graduation ceremony inside the sanctuary for the 4 year old students. Graduating 24 and with that number it is felt that the ceremony can be conducted safely for the families participating while observing current CDL guidelines. 62 are registered for fall 2021 and 20 are registered for the June summer camp. Summer camp to be divided into two groups. Camp will have bible theme (borrowed from this years' vacation bible school) and feature crafts, swimming pool and sprinklers.

Elders Report: Matt Guinn (Moved to this point in meeting due to the visitors in attendance that are present for this reason)

At the meeting held last week he welcomed the new elders that would be serving starting in July.

Justin and Kelly Ryckaert through self-exclusion

Motion made by Matt that effective immediately, starting with the May 23rd services, that the yellow seating placards be removed. Worshipers will be asked to follow CDC guidelines in maintaining and being aware of the 6-foot social distancing suggestion. Motion was supported by Ken. After much discussion the Board voted unanimously to pass this motion.

Motion made by Matt that for the 10:45am service that the wearing of masks would be optional while seated in the sanctuary. This to be effective June 6, 2021, provided conditions and/or guidelines remain in support of this. 8:15 service will continue to require the use of masks. Motion was supported by Sam. Following much discussion the Board voted unanimously to pass this motion.

Some of the discussion that preceded the vote included:

Signage will be posted at entrances requesting those attending to be aware of and honor the most recent guidelines for the wearing of masks.

Ushers and Elders will assist in seating worshipers if requested

Elders report was concluded

Other conversation ensued:

Pastor shared that the office staff are following the guidelines established for businesses by the CDC.

Pre-school continues to wear masks as that requirement has not been lifted.

Small group policy remains in effect as previously approved by the Board

Sarah felt that we should not be discussing at this time any other church activities outside of worship

Pastoral Report/Notes: Pastor Biermann

- Requested any feedback on the parochial report that was shared prior to the meeting.
- Shared with the Board that his book “Handing out Life” has been translated into the Amharic and Oromo languages and 9000 copies are ready and will be shared with the Church leaders within the Ethiopian Evangelical Church Mekane Yesus. Pastor trained Rev. Zegeye Hambissa this past Saturday on how to distribute the book and he and two others will be going over in June and July to train and distribute the book. Plans call for up to half a million leaders of the church will be trained in the principles that God intended concerning relationships and how to walk in the ways of Christ more closely. Follow up visits by Pastor Biermann and others in February 2022 are under consideration with the purpose being to continue their education and training in how to use it even better. The hope is that approximately a year following the follow up training that the full 10 million of the congregation would have received training and be able to carry on from there on their own. Pastor brings this up as he may be coming to the board in the future to:
 - Request permission to return to Ethiopia to provide this training
 - A request may be forthcoming for some funds in support of continuing the training
- Grand Blanc Outreach is still looking for a site to work out of. Are working with FISH and Holy Family Outreach at this time and hope that within the next month they find out how much and what type of support these groups will provide. Pastor may also, in the

future, be asking the board what type of support Faith Lutheran would be willing to offer for this Outreach.

Worship: Laurie Crawford

- Appreciated being on the board for the past four years
- Has seen the board change in so many ways. The Boards use to follow the job responsibilities outlined in the constitution but have drifted away from that and we either need to revisit and edit the constitution or we need to realign the boards' areas of responsibility with the constitution. When she took the position with the Worship Board she thought that she would have been involved with the planning of worship and that has never been the case. In the past few weeks she has not been involved with the Elders discussion and decisions that concerned worship. Concerned with the direction that a lot of the boards have taken and that we have an overabundance of entertainment and fun and games, rather than serious teaching of the Bible. We are leaving that to the pastors but we all have a role in that
